We believe that all people are by nature separated from God and are responsible for their own sin. Salvation, redemption, and forgiveness are freely offered to all by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. When a person repents of sin and accepts Jesus Christ as personal Savior and Lord by trusting Him to save, that person is immediately born again and sealed by the Holy Spirit. All his/her sins are forgiven, and that person becomes a child of God, destined to spend eternity with the Lord.

We believe in the pre-tribulation rapture of the church.

We believe in the personal, visible second coming of Jesus Christ to the earth.

We believe in the pre-millennial second coming of Jesus Christ to the earth. He will return with His saints and set up a kingdom of which there will be no end.

We believe in the gifts of the Holy Spirit mentioned in the Scriptures, and that they are valid for today if they are exercised within scriptural guidelines. We as believers are to covet the best gifts, seeking to exercise them in love so that the whole Body of Christ might be edified. We believe that love is more important than the most spectacular gifts, and without this love all exercise of spiritual gifts is worthless.

We believe that anyone who wills to come to Christ may do so freely as a result of the Holy Spirit's conviction. We reject any theology denying human freewill can be exercised in the receiving of Christ's free gift of salvation.

We reject any introduction of psychology and philosophy which is contrary to Scripture and is in substance "according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ" into biblical teaching.

We reject any over emphasis of dispensationalism that would limit the authority of the New Testament for believers today.

Please understand that we are seeking students that are like minded with us in our view of scripture. This is to limit distractions and divisions among the student body.
